As of today, June 30, 2017, I call for the nominations of four State Administrative Committee Members. The positions which will be up for reelection this year are the North Rep, the Central Rep, the XCEL Athlete Rep and the Educational Rep. The position descriptions and criteria are as follows:

North Sectional Rep – 2-year term

- Actively coached for the past 5 years at a Washington State Club.
- Coached at a Sectional, State or Regional meet in the past 3 years.
- Must work within the North Sectional boundaries.
- Assumes responsibility to communicate with all Club owners, coaches and judges in your Section.
- Communicates closely with the Athlete Reps.
- Must be present at the North Sectional Championships.

Central Sectional Rep – 2-year term

- Actively coached for the past 5 years at a Washington State Club.
- Coached at a Sectional, State or Regional meet in the past 3 years.
- Must work within the Central Sectional boundaries.
- Assumes responsibility to communicate with all Club owners, coaches and judges in your Section.
- Communicates closely with the Athlete Reps.
- Must be present at the Central Sectional Championships.

XCEL Athlete Rep - 2-year term

- Actively coached for the past 5 years at a Washington State Club.
- A current Xcel level Coach.
- Assumes responsibility to communicate with all Club owners and coaches on business pertaining to Xcel athletes.
- Assist Educational Rep with the planning of State Congress.
- Must be present at Xcel State Championships.

Educational Representative - 2-year term

- A judge or coach who has been actively involved as a Washington State USA Gymnastics member for the past five years.
- Has extensive knowledge of Technical Information.
- Responsible for organizing annual State Congress.
- Present at Regional High Tech and Super Camp.

Per Operating Code, State Administrative Committee members must be a minimum of 21 years of age and active in our state's program.

Nominations will close on July 17th, 2016. Candidate statements will be posted online and elections will be held online from August 1st to August 15th, 2017. Newly elected officers will begin their term August 31st. More information on this procedure will follow.

PLEASE make sure your membership status is current so that you will be able to vote!

The nomination form is attached below and should be mailed to me c/o Emerald City Gymnastics Academy. Please make sure I

receive all nominations by July 17th, 2017. If there is only one qualified nominee for any position, I, as the State Chairman will cast one vote and no general election will be necessary.
